- Underclothing
- Socks
- Sleepwear
- Shoes
- Winter boots
- Winter coat or jacket
- Stocking hat
- Winter gloves or mittens
- Sweater or sweatshirt
- Personal hygiene products
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Comb and/or brush
