

## **CIRCLE OF NATIONS SCHOOL DRESS CODE**

The students are required to wear a school uniform which includes:

- Black or Tan (khaki) pants
- CNS logo t-shirt (provided by CNS)
- CNS hoodie (provided by CNS)

Students that earn Honor status will be allowed to wear appropriate street wear.

**The Parents/Guardians are requested to provide the following items:**

- 3 pairs of black or tan khaki type pants
- 2 pairs of jeans
- Underclothing
- Socks
- Sleepwear
- Shoes (don't send more than 2 pair)
- Winter wear: coat, boots, hat, gloves
- Sweater or sweatshirt
- Personal hygiene items

**CNS WILL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:**

- Pillows, blankets, sheets, pillowcases, towels, washcloths, bath soap, shampoo, and school supplies.
